

WHAT IS A NEUROLOGIST?

A neurologist is a medical doctor with specialized training in diagnosing, treating and managing disorders of the brain and nervous system. A neurologist's educational background and medical training includes an undergraduate degree, four years of medical school, a one-year internship and three years of specialized training.

Neurologists treat disorders of the nervous system, brain, spinal cord, nerves and muscles. Common neurological disorders include: stroke, Alzheimer's disease, headache, epilepsy, Parkinson's disease, sleep disorders, multiple sclerosis, pain, tremor, brain and spinal cord injuries, brain tumors, peripheral nerve disorders and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.

PRESCRIPTION POLICY:

Providers will authorize prescription refills at their discretion as medically appropriate. Please do not wait until you are out of medications before requesting a refill. It may take up to 48 hours for your prescription to be refilled, so please take the necessary precautions so that you are not without your medications.

Physicians on-call for medical emergencies on the weekends and evenings will not refill routine medications or pain medications.

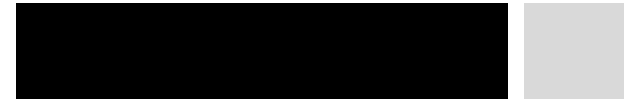


It is your responsibility to mail prescriptions directly to your mail order company. Please allow adequate shipping time.

Routine maintenance medications will not be refilled if you have not been seen within the past two years.
